Code 1079. Migration, International Justice and Human Rights Length/Duración: 90 minutes

The aim of this workshop is to present proposals related to the theory of justice and to policies that receiving countries should implement in order to respect and recognize universal human rights of migrants. This workshop will also explain how social conflict involving migrants could be prevented by adopting a system of justice that recognizes the human rights of migrants. It will also propose to broaden the definition of human rights violations to include debilitation conditions resulting from natural disasters, so that immigrants could be legally treated as refugees.
